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# Feedback

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- Feedback is GOOD!
  - We give feedback to students
  - Feedback in assessments helps students know where they went wrong.
- Feedback to teachers from students
  - Allow us to know where we went wrong.
  - Where can we improve?
  - What's perfect as it is?

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# Choices, Surveys and Feedback

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- Three activities in Moodle seem to sound like a survey type feedback thing.
  - Choice:
    - ask a single question
    - get a single answer
    - probably one of my favourite activities, but not suited to what we're trying to do.

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# Choices, Surveys and Feedback

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- Survey:
  - used to assess and stimulate learning in online environments
  - COLLES (Constructivist On-Line Learning Environment Survey)
  - ATTLS (Attitudes to Thinking and Learning Survey)
  - i.e. we're getting into online learning theory here
  - You can't change the questions.
  - The survey isn't useless, but it's not useful for our purposes.

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# Choices, Surveys and Feedback

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- Feedback:
  - Allows you to create custom surveys and get the results from your students/users.
  - Non-graded
    - Don't use it as an assessment event
    - Great for Teacher or Course evaluation

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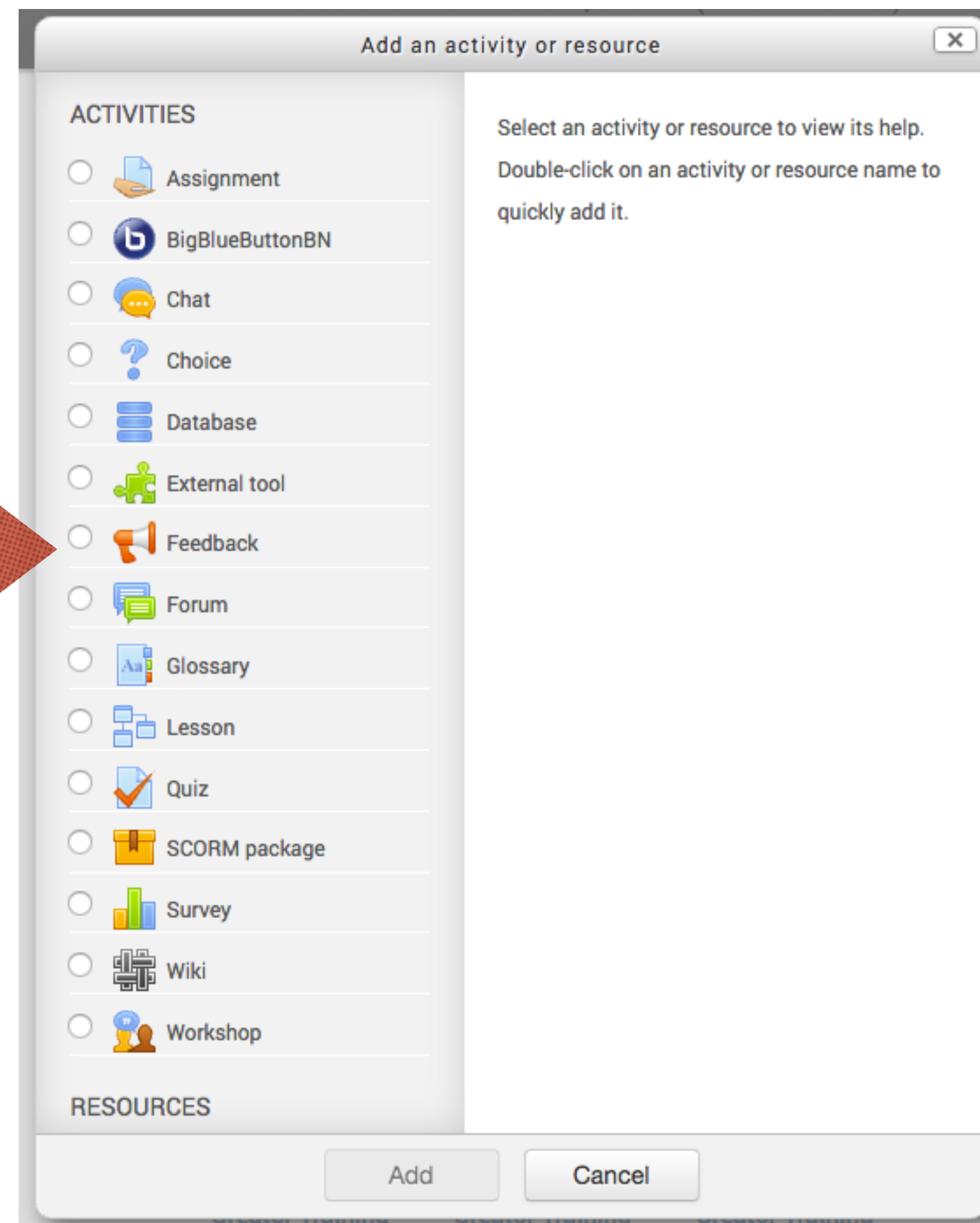
# Feedback vs Quiz

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- Quiz is more suited to an assessment event
  - Feeds into the Grade Book
  - More complex question types
  - Better question bank and question category management
- Could you do all this using a Quiz?
  - Maybe, but Feedback has better reporting for this kind of thing
    - Easily see how people responded to a question where as Quiz more designed to report if people were correct
  - I think the UI for Feedback looks better for this kind of activity
