General

Default for An Example Quiz

Question name*

Question text*

The Question Name is more an identifier for teachers and admin.

The Question Text is what the student sees.

Traditional, but remember can be used with multiple right or wrong answers. And can have an unlimited number of options.

Really just a multiple choice with 2 options.

Match one list to another (referred to as "Questions" and "Answers"). But you can add more answers than questions!

Students have to type in a short answer. If it matches the pattern, correct! Can be tricky, if there's multiple correct answers.


Like short answer, but with numbers. You can specify an amount of acceptable error, and units.


Get students to write answers in long form. Be careful, probably a bad idea to ask them to write 3000 words. Teacher has to mark this one.


Like numerical, but you give Moodle a formula and a range and it will pick the numbers.


Like calculated, but generates a few plausible options for the student to pick.



 Calculated simple

Like calculated, but a simpler interface.


 Drag and drop into text

Students drag words onto blanks in text.


 Drag and drop markers


 Drag and drop onto image

Student drag words onto a picture. Or sometimes pictures onto a picture. Think flags onto a map.

 Embedded answers (Cloze)


Students have a dropdown of choices to fill in blanks in text.


 Random short-answer matching


 Select missing words


Just like Matching, but it draws from Short Answer questions in the current *Category*.

Like Drag & Drop into Text or Cloze, you select words in a paragraph from a dropdown list of choice.

This was from last fortnight. It's just a description, a label, a block of text we can add.

So what's the Question Bank?

- Generating these questions takes a long time.
- The Question Bank is a way to save, share and reuse questions.

- ➕ **a new question**
- ➕ **from question bank**
- ➕ **a random question**

- While editing a quiz, this menu option shows up.
- It's also under "Course administration"
- Clicking on "Questions" shows us all the questions we have access to.
 - Course Level
 - (Course) Category Level
 - Site Level
- This means we can create a Quiz in Course A and use questions from the question bank of Course B.


